NEW ZEALAND APPRENTICESHIP IN WATER TREATMENT

WHO IS THIS QUALIFICATION FOR?

This qualification is suitable for those already working in the Water industry. You must be employed in a drinking-water or wastewater treatment plant.

In the 20 month programme, you will learn the theory and practical skills you will need to become a treatment plant operator, while you earn money, and gain a nationally recognised NZQA Level 4 qualification.

YOU WILL LEARN HOW TO:

- Be responsible for the day-to-day operation of a treatment plant
- Operate the equipment, control the processes and monitor the treatment plant
- Collect, analyse and interpret water/wastewater samples
- Protect public health and the environment
- Comply with the New Zealand Drinking Water Standards/Resource Consents

HOW DO I COMPLETE THE QUALIFICATION?

- On-line learning and assessment
- Off-job block courses
- Treatment plant (SCADA) simulator
- A walk through your plant with a registered Connexis Assessor



HOW WILL CONNEXIS HELP ME?

A New Zealand Apprenticeship is a partnership between you, your employer and Connexis. You will be assigned a Connexis Customer Service Account Manager (CSAM) who will work with you to help guide you through the assessments and training, ensuring that you receive any help you might need to complete your qualification within the required time period.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR FEES FREE?

The New Zealand Apprenticeship in Water Treatment is eligible for Fees Free funding. The first two years of training and assessment fees will be covered by the Government for those people who are eligible.

Who is eligible for FEES FREE?

Eligible trainees must:

- Be allowed to work in New Zealand
- Not be enrolled in school when they start training, and either:
- Have been enrolled at school in 2017 or earlier in 2018, or
- Not have undertaken previous study or training of more than 60 credits*, except while at school

*gained with a tertiary provider or achieved through industry training, and includes overseas training and study
