

RECOGNITION OF CURRENT COMPETENCE

An option which allows you to gain a New Zealand qualification by recognising the skills and knowledge you have already gained through your previous work/study.

HOW DOES THE RCC PROCESS WORK?

- You will work with a Connexis Customer Service Account Manager (CSAM) to develop a portfolio of evidence
- This will be given to an Assessor, who will also have a professional discussion with you and assess your skills against the qualification requirements
- The process will take 6-9 months to complete



AM I ELIGIBLE?

- You must have at least 5 years' experience working within your industry
- You must be currently employed in the industry at the level of the qualification, and have been for the last two years
- You must be able to provide evidence of previous work experience (for example, work sheets, employer reference, photos, videos etc.)

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

- Contact your local CSAM to check your eligibility for RCC assessment
- If you are eligible, a RCC assessor will be assigned to you
- Your CSAM is there to support and guide you through the process

Civil Trades Certification combines a recognised trade qualification with certified hours of experience, leading onto recognition as a Certified Tradesperson.
