The apprenticeship programme is designed to provide the electricity supply industry with people able to work in transmission line maintenance as a line mechanic or structure maintainer.

## WHERE CAN IT TAKE YOU?

Graduates of the line mechanics strand will be able to work as a line mechanic on transmission lines and are eligible to apply for registration as a line mechanic with the Electrical Workers Registration Board (EWRB).

Graduates of the structure maintenance strand will be able to carry out maintenance of electricity supply structures.
