HOW IT WORKS

Students interested in the Gateway will be placed at a suitable local Infrastructure company to begin their programme (we can help with this).

To get started, each school will need to complete an enrolment form and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)– this outlines the agreement between the school and Connexis. The school will then be invoiced.
