### BLOCK COURSE INFORMATION

- **Pricing:** The cost for each programme is **\$10,500 + GST**. This will be invoiced in 3 separate stages.
  1. **\$4,500 + GST** upon confirmation of enrolment
  2. **\$3,000 + GST** upon attendance at Block 2
  3. **\$3,000 + GST** upon attendance at Block 3
- **Capacity:** Each cohort will be restricted to a maximum of 20 enrolments. A company is restricted to a maximum of 10 enrolments on any one cohort.
- **Cohort enrolment:** No new enrolments for a cohort will be accepted within two-weeks of the Block Course 1 start date. This is to ensure that learners have enough time to prepare for the block course. Following enrolment, the cohort confirmation, information and resources will be shared with learners.
- **Block Course Attendance requirement:** Invoices will be sent out as per registered cohort dates. If a learner misses one of their cohort Block Courses, the invoice will still be processed. Learners must be able to attend all three Block Courses within their cohort group. Should a learner miss a Block Course, they may need to wait until a space becomes available within a different cohort.
- **Programme requirements:** Learners must hold an NZQA Level 4 Water Treatment qualification or be able to prove equivalent knowledge, skills and experience.
- **Travel, accommodation and food:** Learners will be responsible for organising their own travel and accommodation. There will be no catering provided, but some helpful information such as locations to grab lunch will be provided closer to the Block Course start date.
- **Provider:** The delivery and assessment of the block course units will be the responsibility of WSP OPUS and their tutors. Learners will submit assessment evidence via the Connexis e-learning platform.
