All infrastructure companies in New Zealand may apply for full membership. Infrastructure companies include:

- Generation, transmission and distribution network asset owners
- Enterprises contracting to those asset owners for the installation, operation and maintenance of industry assets
- Electricity retailers
- Consultants to the industry, including companies and organisations which represent groupings of enterprises within the industry;
- The employees of enterprises, retailers, consultants and organisations that contract to asset owners.
