Graduates of the Electrical Works strand will also be able to apply knowledge of the principles of electricity supply, legislation, and Industry standards.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This is an entry-level qualification with no entry requirements.. However, you must have a job in the energy sector in order to complete this qualification. By enrolling in the Electrical Works strand, you will be able to apply for an Electrical Workers' Registration Board Trainee Limited Certificate.

HOW IT WORKS

This qualification will take around 6-12 months to complete and is achieved through a mix of on-job and off-job assessment.

WHERE THIS CAN TAKE YOU

Following the completion of this qualification, you will be able to work in introductory roles in the Electricity Supply industry or continue to further training. Next steps could include qualifications in Utility Arboriculture, Cable Jointing, Line Mechanic Distribution, Electrical Trade, Transmission Line Maintenance, or Substation Maintenance.
