#### **Infrastructure Worksites**

Gateway Programme (Micro-credential) (Level 3)

This programme is intended to build on the Introduction to Infrastructure Works Micro-credential at Level 2, for high-school students in Year 11, 12 or 13.

When students have achieved all the unit standards they will be able to:

- · Locate features from plans
- Apply safe practices to work
- Describe commonly used materials
- Erosion and sediment control on infrastructure worksites.

This programme is a combination of theory and practical unit, and can be completed through paper based workbooks or through eLearning.

After completing this programme students may choose move on to the NZC in Infrastructure Works L3, all units in this micro-credential count towards that qualification.
