MODES OF DELIVERY

eLearning

Online Learning and on-job assessment through the Connexis Learning Management System (LMS). You will receive a login to access the resources.

Totara - Mobile App

This programme is also available through the free eLearning mobile app, Totara. With the app, you can quickly and securely access your eLearning programme, courses, and assessment activities through your mobile device.
