



Skills Covered:

- Working safely and to regulatory and legislative requirements when maintaining vegetation around electricity supply power lines and cables.
- · Using insulating tools and plant equipment to ensure safety when necessary.

Entry Requirements:

Learmers must hold, or currently be enrolled in the New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Introductory) (Level 2) and the New Zealand Certificate in Horticulture (Level 3) with the strand in Arboriculture, or demonstrate equivalent skills, in order to enter this programme. They must also have a job in the infrastructure industry.

Modes of Delivery:

This programme is achieved on-job or off-job and is completed through workbooks, or through a provider.

Progression Pathways:

Graduates of this qualification will be able to work in the Electricity Supply industry as a Utility Arborist. This qualification can lead to higher electricity supply (non-arborist) qualifications such as the New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Line Mechanic Distribution) (Level 4).
