Entry Requirements:

It is recommended that the learner completes introductory applicator training prior to enrolment and have experience in agrichemical application. The learner must be employed in the agrichemical industry and be exposed to the relevant skills covered.

Modes of Delivery:

This programme is assessed on-job and is completed through workbooks. It can also be achieved through Advanced Portfolio Assessment (APA). If the learner has a minimum of 4 years experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence from the past 24 months linking to the level of this programme's unit standards, then APA could be a great option to recognise existing skills.

Progression Pathways:

This qualification complies with NZS 8409:2004 Management of Agrichemicals. This qualification can assist in streamlining the graduates Worksafe **Certified Handler Compliance Certificate** application. Gaining this qualification also allows graduates to apply to become a Registered Chemical Applicator (RCA) through Growsafe.
