If the learner has a minimum of 4 years experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence from the past 24 months linking to the level of this programme's unit standards, then APA could be a great option to recognise existing skills.

Entry Requirements:

The learner must be employed in the bitumen surfacing industry and be exposed to the relevant skills covered. The learner must have the appropriate class of driver licence and endorsement for any vehicle being driven.

Progression Pathways:

This qualification can lead towards Civil Trade Certification (CTC). Learners can also continue their recognised pathways to the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Single Site Supervision) (Level 4), the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Projects) or the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Contract Management) (Level 5).
