Modes of Delivery:

If the learner has a minimum of four years experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence from the past 24 months linking to the level of this programme's unit standards, then APA could be a great option to recognise existing skills.

Entry Requirements:

The learner must be employed in the infrastructure industry and be exposed to the relevant skills covered. It is recommended the learner hold the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Level 3) before being signed up to this qualification.

Progression Pathways:

This qualification can lead towards Civil Trade Certification (CTC). Graduates can also carry on to achieve the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Single Site Supervision) (Level 4), NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Projects) or the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Contract Management) (Level 5).
