LEARN HOW TO

- Protect public health and the environment.
- Implement, monitor and communicate health and safety requirements.
- Operate a drinking-water treatment plant to meet organisational and regulatory requirements.
- Monitor drinking-water treatment plant operation and interpret compliance and operational data.
- Sample, test and report drinking-water procedures for drinking-water treatment.

The Multistage Processes strand will enable you to:

- Operate a drinking-water treatment plant with a combination of multistage processes to meet organisational and regulatory requirements.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no entry requirements for this programme, but you must be working in a drinking-water treatment plant as an operator. You should also have reasonable knowledge of maths and science to grasp the basic principles of this programme. To complete the optional strand you must be in a plant that has enough separate treatment processes to satisfy the elective section of the training plan.

HOW IT WORKS

It is expected this programme will take around 12 - 20 months to complete. Achievement of this qualification occurs through a combination of e-learning and assessment, off-job block courses and workplace assessment.

WHERE THIS CAN TAKE YOU

This programme will recognise your skills as a drinking-water treatment plant operator and can lead to a New Zealand Diploma in Drinking-water Treatment (Level 5).
