HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED

This programme is available to be completed through:

- On-job assessment through printed workbooks, or
- Advanced Portfolio Assessment (APA), if the learner:
 - has a minimum of 4 years experience working in the industry at the level of the qualification,
 - are currently working in a relevant role within the industry; and
 - can provide a portfolio of current evidence from within the last 24 months linking them to the level of this programme's unit standards.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol in this programme the learner must be employed in the infrastructure industry and exposed to the skills covered within this programme. It is recommended the learner hold the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Level 3), or demonstrate equivalent skills and knowledge, before being signed up to this qualification.

TRAINING PATHWAYS
