



Skills Covered:

- Applying knowledge of land surveying fundamentals to surveying operations.
- Applying safe work practices when operating in a surveying environment.
- Setting up, checking calibration, and maintaining surveying equipment.
- Undertaking survey measurement tasks and checks.
- Applying effective communication when undertaking surveying operations.

Entry Requirements:

The learner must be employed in the surveying industry and exposed to the relevant skills covered. They should also have NCEA Level 1 Maths and English.

Modes of Delivery:

This programme is assessed on-job and is completed through workbooks.

Progression Pathways:

The NZ Certificate in Surveying is the essential first step for those wanting to pursue a career in the Land Surveying sector. It can be achieved as a stand alone qualification, or can be part of a pathway leading to higher roles in Surveying. Graduates could be employed as Assistant Surveyors in a wide variety of settings, including Land Surveying firms and large infrastructure companies.
