- Managing and optimising drinking-water treatment plant operations to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.
- Implementing, monitoring and communicating health and safety requirements for a drinkingwater treatment plant.

Entry Requirements:

To enrol in this programme the learner must hold the NZC in Drinking-Water Treatment (Level 4), and be working in a drinking-water treatment plant. It is recommended the learner be working in a plant operator role.

Modes of Delivery:

This programme is assessed through a combination of e-learning assessment, off-job block courses and an on-site assessment.

Progression Pathways:

Graduates of this qualification can progress to supervisory, management and business qualifications such as the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Procurement Procedures (Level 6) and or the NZ Certificate in Infrastructure Asset Management (Level 6).
