LEARN HOW TO

- Make and break high voltage connections up to 33kV using live line glove and barrier procedures.
- Replace and install hardware on structures using live line glove and barrier procedures up to 33kV.
- Remove and install pole structures using live line glove and barrier procedures up to 33kV.
- Apply knowledge of electrical codes of practice, electricity supply industry standards and operating procedures when carrying out work on live lines up to 33kV.
- Replace pole structures on live lines to meet electricity supply industry standards using glove and barrier procedures.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need to be working in the electricity supply industry. You must have completed the New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Distribution Live Line Stick) (Level 4).

HOW IT WORKS

This programme will take around 10-12 months to complete. You can complete this programme through block courses with MITA (ready to go) or Lines and Cables Training (working through a contract).

WHERE THIS CAN TAKE YOU

You'll be qualified to use glove and barrier procedures as a live line worker in the distribution sector of the electricity supply industry. This programme can lead into the New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Power Technician) (Level 5).
