As you work through this programme, you will learn the skills and knowledge to coordinate and work within a team to complete bitumen surfacing construction site works.

LEARN HOW TO

- Assess and prepare a site for bitumen surfacing construction
- Implement quality work processes on a bitumen surfacing construction worksite
- Safely operate bitumen surfacing construction equipment and machinery
- Assess a worksite for health and safety
- Support and mentor a team onsite

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

It is recommended that those enrolling achieve the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Level 3) or demonstrate equivalent knowledge.

HOW IT WORKS

This programme will take 19 months to complete and is achieved on-job through a mixture of theory and practical assessments. Recognition of Current Competence (RCC) is also available for this programme. If you have 3 to 5 years of experience working in the industry, and can provide a portfolio of evidence, then RCC could be a great option for you to get qualified.

WHERE THIS CAN TAKE YOU

This qualification can lead towards Civil Trade Certification (CTC). You can also carry on to the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Single Site Supervision) (Level 4), the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Projects) or the New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works (Contract Management) (Level 5).
