

New Zealand Certificate in Electricity Supply (Introduction) Level 2

When a student completes both the *Power Up* and *Switched On* Gateway micro-credentials, and a First Aid course unit standards 6401 & 6402, they are entitled to be awarded the *New Zealand Certificate (NZC) in Electricity Supply (Introduction) Level 2*.

This NZC is seen by industry employers as the entry level qualification to work in the Electricity Supply Industry.

Students must have completed the following, with all unit standards reported on the students' NZQA Record of Achievement, to be eligible for this certificate:
