# Temporary Traffic Management (TTM): Applying Controls to Low-risk, Low-impact Activities in the Road Reserve



This course is designed for people working on the road reserve who need to apply appropriate temporary traffic management control measures to manage associated risk while carrying out a low-risk, low-impact activity.

#### WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

This course covers the knowledge and skills required to manage risk and address the safety of relevant stakeholders who engage with traffic management risk controls.

It covers:

- Understanding risk assessment and risk mitigation controls within an activity and environment context.
- Verifying the effectiveness of controls and applying organisational requirements for pre-site checks.
- Reviewing the risk assessment and actioning revisions onsite.
- Understanding safe locations and approaches, identifying trigger points, in line with a traffic management plan (TMP).
- Installation, maintenance, and uplift of low-risk control measures for the activity to be safely undertaken.
- Capturing and recording operations information relevant to the role.

Graduates of this micro-credential may be employed in roles completing an activity where they are working on the road reserve.

#### **HOW THE COURSE IS DELIVERED**

This course is delivered through a combination of online learning and assessment, and an on-job practical assessment.

Learners are supported by a Customer Service Account Manager and assessor throughout their training.

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To enrol for this course, trainees must already work in temporary traffic management, be exposed to the skills covered, and have access to a temporary traffic management worksite to complete on-job practical assessments.

#### TRAINING PATHWAYS

Graduates who hold this micro-credential will be able to continue their training within temporary traffic management by completing further Level 3 temporary traffic management micro-credentials.

### WHAT IS A MICRO-CREDENTIAL?

A micro-credential is a short, NZQA-recognised training course where you can earn between 5-40 credits when successfully completed. Micro-credential courses either lead to a qualification or focus on specialised skills and knowledge that top-up a full qualification certificate, or apprenticeship programme.
