## Dig it - Civil Gateway Programme

Micro-credential in Introduction to Infrastructure Works (Level 2, 23 Credits)

This Micro-credential (MC) introduces students to the civil infrastructure industry, and is for students in Year 11, 12 or 13.

At the completion of this MC, students will be able to:

- Use hand tools and excavate manually.
- Work safely and well on an infrastructure worksite.
- Have an understanding of the infrastructure industry.

This MC is a combination of theory and practical units and can be completed through workbooks or eLearning. This programme is also available through the free eLearning app 'Totara'. Totara allows quick and secure access to eLearning programmes, courses and assessment activities whenever and wherever it suits.

Upon completion, this MC offers a pathway to the *Micro-credential in Infrastructure Worksites* (Level 3) or the *New Zealand Certificate in Infrastructure Works* (Level 2).

- Gateway information.
- Learner assessment and notes or eLearning logins for online resources.
