Question: Why is the pricing discount being offered?

Answer: The current learner fees are a limited-time special rate designed to support the infrastructure industries Connexis serves. Q. Are my learners still able to get the Fees Free if they enrol in a discounted programme?

A: Yes. Check the Fees Fee website for more information on Fees Free.

Q. Can employers still get the Apprenticeship Boost?

A: Yes, if the training programme is eligible for Apprenticeship Boost.

Q. Can I make a split payment for the invoicing?

A. Yes, split invoicing as per existing standard terms applies to incentive prices.

Q. Are there any restrictions on enrolments?

A. Yes, the learner must be employed within the industry. The Employer needs to be able to illustrate that they can provide the learner exposure to the work required to complete the training programmes and commit to supporting the learner to complete within the required duration of the training programme.

Discounts are only available where the fee payer's Connexis account is up-to-date and there are no outstanding invoices.

Q. Are there any other Terms and Conditions?

A. Applicants enrolling in the NZA in Infrastructure Works (Civil) (L4) and who choose to also register their interest in continuing on with Civil Trades will have 4 months following gaining their qualification to apply for their CT certification in order to be eligible for the Connexis Civil Trades scholarship. After that period, the scholarship will no longer be valid.
